A solid film professional, Anni has worked as a producer for the Helsinki International Film Festival – Love & Anarchy and as production and marketing coordinator at Don Films. She has spent the last few years working to internationalise the Finnish film and television industries, namely at Audiovisual Finland (formerly called FAVEX), where she worked on export initiatives and international communications. Before that, she worked in International Affairs at the Sibelius Academy University of the Arts Helsinki, where she coordinated several global music networks and organised the 2014 Percussion Plus music festival. She previously lived in the UK where she studied Drama, was a university music scholar for Classical Voice and later gained an MA in Film Studies. She then went on to work at several high-profile arts institutions as well as NBC in London. Born in Finland in 1988 but having grown up in the United States and having lived most of her life abroad, Anni also works as a freelance translator in the film industry.
